DATA&LAW - JUNE 2018 - THE HAGUE, THE NETHERLANDS

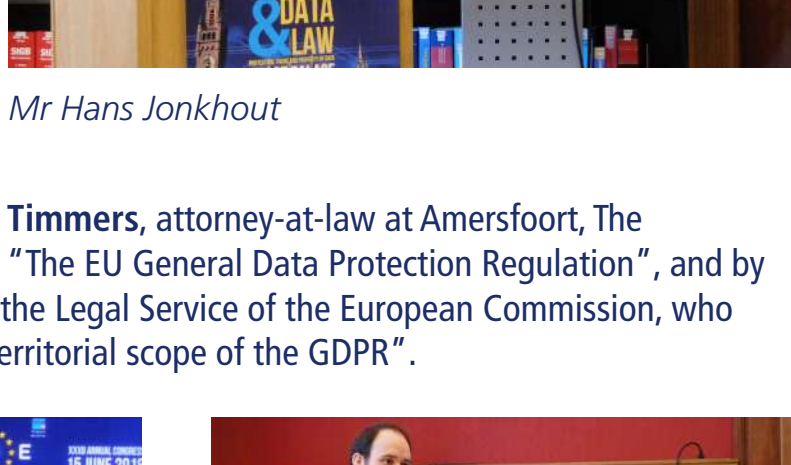

The Palace officially opened on 28 August 1913, and was originally built to provide a home for the PCA, a court created to end war by the Hague Convention of 1899. The level both of speakers and assistants created a very special atmosphere in the room, full of debates and questions of the **highest level on the matter**.

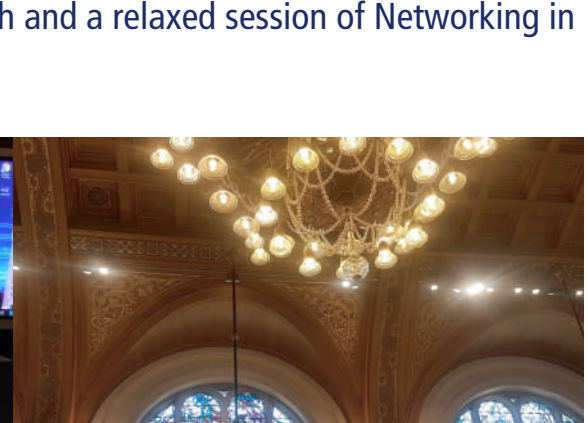

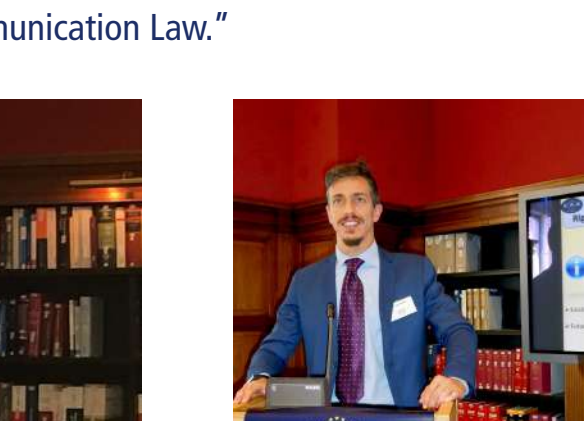

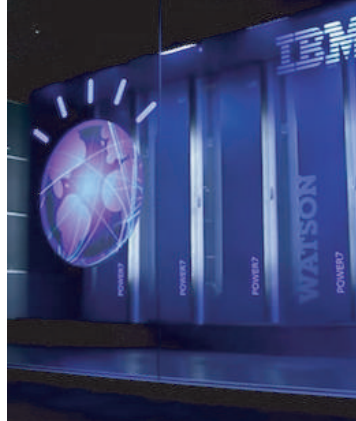


Mr Dan Shefet receiving the U.A.E. medal of honor from our President Mr Agustín Cruz.

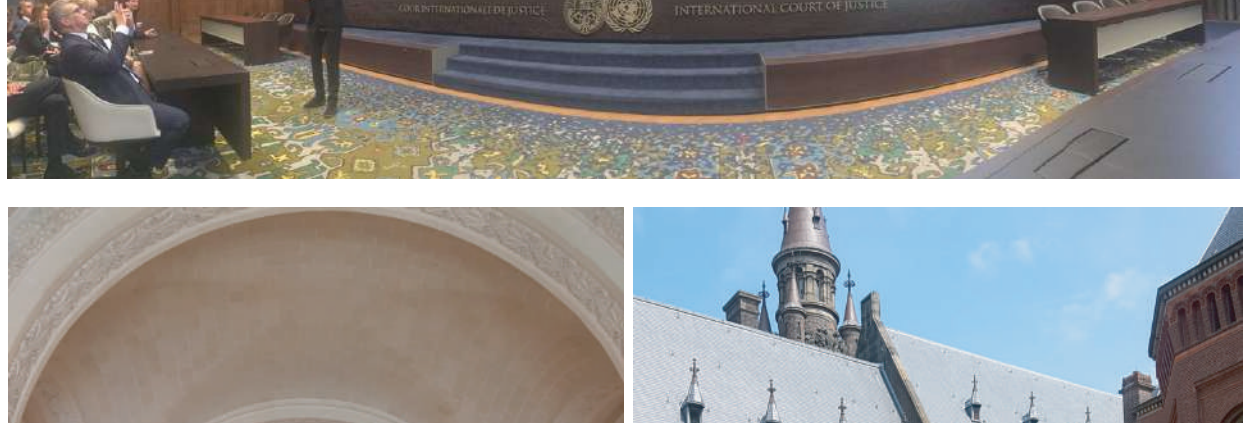

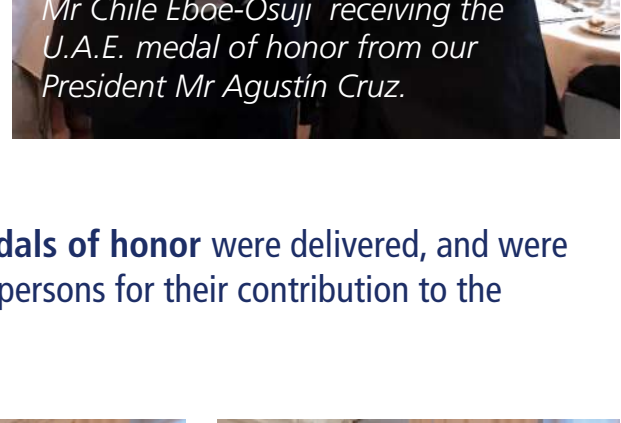

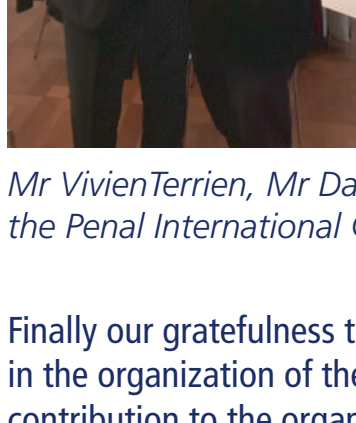

Mr Chile Eboe-Osuji receiving the U.A.E. medal of honor from our President Mr Agustín Cruz.

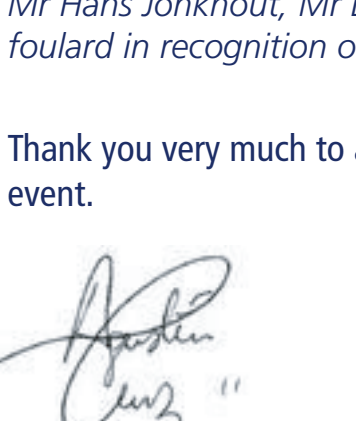
This night during the Gala dinner, three **medals of honor** were delivered, and were named as **honorific members** three more persons for their contribution to the European Lawyers' Union.



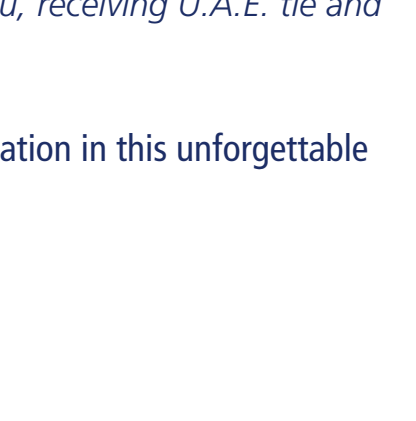
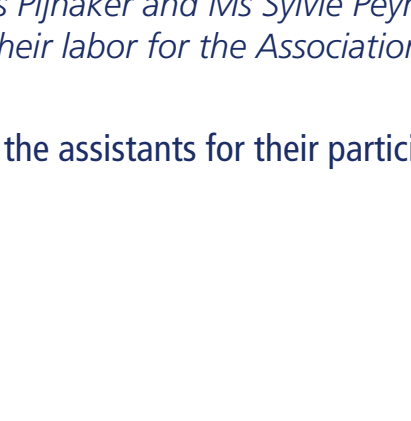


